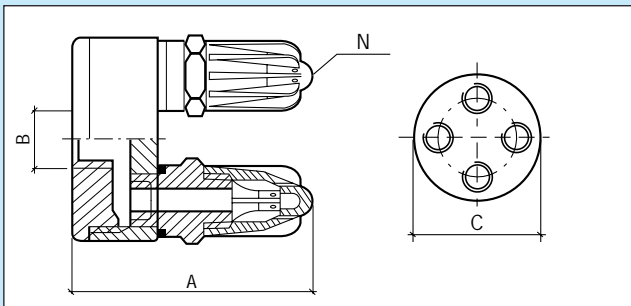

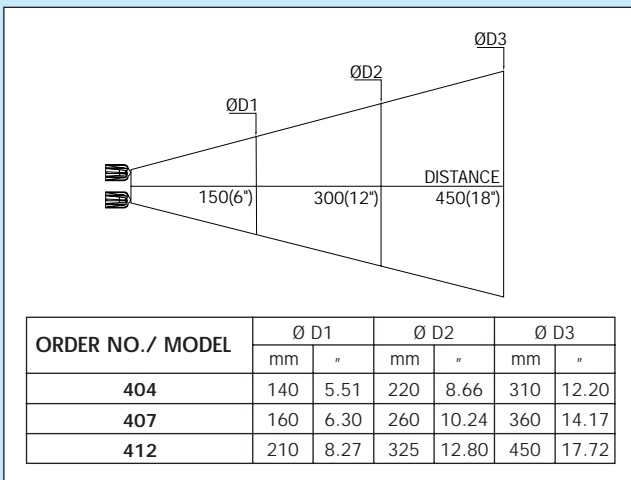

APPLICATIONS



The picture shows an application at Metron Steel in Illinois, USA. Here, 6 Silvent 412s are mounted on adjustable 3/4" swivel joints. The joints allow optimum positioning of each 412. Silvent's nozzles are used to blow the steel sheet free of dust and moisture before it passes on to a leveling device and precutting. The air cone generated by the Silvent 412s effectively cleans the steel. Air consumption has been reduced by 68% in relation to the open pipe blowing previously used.



In this application for ejecting parts from a press, a noise level reduction of more than 50% was attained when open pipe was replaced by the Silvent 404.



The Silvent 407 is used by Jaguar in Castle Bromich to blow their cars clean prior to painting.



The picture shows a blow-off station for plastic pipe. Silvent 407 nozzle is mounted on a pneumatic rotor arm. The arm is automatically regulated and moves to the opening of the pipe to blow out the long pieces.
